Remove Color Casts Quickly and Effectively Using Remove Color Cast

To apply the Remove Color Cast filter to the image, click on the Remove Color Cast from the Selective Tool or open from the Filter menu and then select Color Efex Pro 3.0 and then select Remove Color Cast filter from the Filter List on the left.

Tip: Once inside the Color Efex Pro 3.0 interface, you can hide the Filter List by simply clicking on the Show Image Only button located at the top left corner of the interface (Fig. 1). Clicking on this will provide more room to work with an image.

To modify or adjust the application of this filter on the image, go to the filter control area. In the filter control area, there are two controls: Color and Strength.

Color – Specifies the color to be removed from the image. Move the slider until the selected color matches the predominant color cast in the image.

Strength – Controls the degree to which you want to apply the filter. Moving the slider from right to left applies more or less warmth to the image depending on your preference.

To see a before and after preview of the image, click on the Preview checkbox (Fig. 2) or you can select and click on the Views to see a Side-by-side Preview or a Split Preview of the filter effect applied to the image (Fig. 3).

Once the optimum adjustments have been made using the filter controls, you may simply click on the OK button (Fig.4) at the bottom of the interface and the filter will be applied globally throughout the image.



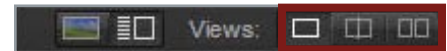

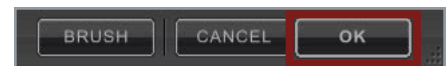
